

UNIVERSITY OF PHOENIX STADIUM GAME DAY PARKING

FASTEST ARRIVAL:

Please place your parking permit on your rearview mirror with the color side of the pass facing out your front windshield. This will aid the Glendale Police and parking personnel in getting you to the proper area. The best and fastest route (located on the map provided on the back of the parking pass) to access Carpark NP from:

- Northbound on 101 - Exit at Bethany Home Road and turn left (west) to 99th Ave.
- Southbound on 101 - Exit at Bethany Home Road then turn right (west) to 99th Ave.
- At 99th Ave turn right (north) to the Maryland Ave bridge turn right (east) to the Red Entry at 95th.
- **Stay in the LEFT lane approaching the Red Entry to speed access to Carpark NP.**
- Upon reaching the parking attendants within the Carpark, please detach and give the bottom portion of your permit to the attendant.

Following these procedures will expedite your access to your lot significantly.

DISABLED PARKING:

Season ticket holders should contact the Cardinals Ticket Office at 602-379-0102 for more information on disabled parking within Sportsman's Park. Disabled parking permits for Sportsman's Park have been issued in advance to season ticket holders that have provided a copy of their state-issued disabled hangtag or license plate. Signed handicapped parking spaces will be filled in a first-come, first-served manner. Additional overflow disabled parking spaces located adjacent to the signed spaces will also be available to assist disabled guests. Those season ticket holders wishing to park in a disabled area must contact the Cardinals Ticket Office in advance of the game day.

For those with a Cardinals-issued Carpark NP disabled parking permit, please display your Carpark NP disabled permit so the attendants can direct you. Upon arrival to Carpark NP please follow the posted signage and keep in the left most lane to aid in an unobstructed path to the Disabled parking area.

The Cardinals have a courtesy cart service available to those season ticket holders that park in disabled parking locations. The courtesy carts are in operation from 3 hours prior to kickoff until 1 hour after the conclusion of the game.

ONCE IN LOTS:

Please follow the guidelines:

- A parking permit is valid for one (1) parking space only. Vehicles pulling a trailer will not be allowed access at Sportsman's Park. Vehicles taking more than one parking space or parked incorrectly will be subject to tow. All fees associated with the removal and impounding of the vehicle will be the responsibility of the owner.
- All vehicles entering Sportsman's Park will be directed into a parking spot. Fans are asked to follow the direction of the parking staff to quickly park their vehicle.
- Fans that wish to park next to friends must arrive at the same time. Parking spots cannot be reserved or saved for fans arriving at a later time.
- Tailgating in the parking lots must be limited to the area directly behind the vehicle. Tailgating in empty stalls is prohibited. We encourage all fans to use the lawn areas.
- Fans will not be allowed to rope off or section off large tailgate areas. The Great Lawn is large enough for fans to spread out and enjoy themselves.
- Like season tickets, season parking permits can be revoked for non-compliance to Sportsman's Park guidelines.

GOING HOME:

All traffic exiting Carpark NP will be directed West on Maryland Ave to 99th Ave. At 99th Ave traffic can go either North or South to access Loop 101.
