

**Frequently Asked Questions  
Arizona Cardinals Special Plate  
Available January 31, 2010**

- 1. Are there any eligibility requirements for purchasing an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
There are no customer eligibility requirements for an Arizona Cardinals plate, which can be issued to an Arizona registered passenger car, pick-up truck, SUV, van, or commercial motor vehicle with a declared gross vehicle weight up to 26,000 pounds. However, the plate cannot be issued to a trailer, a motorcycle, or a commercial vehicle with a declared gross vehicle weight over 26,000 pounds.
- 2. What is the cost for an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
You will be charged an annual special plate fee of \$25 plus an initial postage fee of \$2.49 for a standard Arizona Cardinals plate (one plate). If you choose to order a personalized Arizona Cardinals plate (two plates), you will be charged an annual plate fee of \$25, a personalization fee of \$25 plus an initial postage fee of \$3.00.
- 3. Can I personalize my Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
Yes, for an additional annual personalization plate fee of \$25 you may personalize your Arizona Cardinals plate. Total annual fees for a personalized Arizona Cardinals plate would be \$50 plus an initial postage fee of \$3.00.
- 4. Is there a limit to the amount of characters I can place on my personalized Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
You may use up to six characters to personalize your Arizona Cardinals plate.
- 5. Can I order a disability Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
Yes, the disability option is available on both a standard and personalized Arizona Cardinals plate. Please note that the available characters for a disability personalized Arizona Cardinals plate are reduced to five to accommodate for the disability symbol.
- 6. Is there an additional charge for the disability option for an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**  
There is no fee charged in addition to the special or personalization plate fees charged for a disability option for an Arizona Cardinals plate.
- 7. How many plates will I be issued?**  
For a standard or disability Arizona Cardinals plate, you will be issued one plate. You will be issued two plates only if you purchase the personalized plate option.
- 8. Does any part of my special plate fee go to a charitable organization?**  
Yes, \$17 of the special plate fee is an annual donation to Cardinals Charities which funds programs designed to improve the lives of children, women and minorities within the state of Arizona.
- 9. Can I apply for an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate for a vehicle registered out-of-state?**  
No, Arizona Cardinals plates are for Arizona registered vehicles only.

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**10. May I purchase an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate for someone else as a gift?**

You may purchase an Arizona Cardinals plate for someone else as a gift, as long as the vehicle is registered in Arizona and meets the eligibility requirements mentioned in the first FAQ.

**11. Can I purchase an Arizona Cardinals plate for my motorcycle?**

No, Arizona Cardinals plates are not available for motorcycles.

**12. How do I purchase an Arizona Cardinals Special Plate?**

- In person by visiting any Motor Vehicle Division or Authorized Third Party Provider office during regular business hours
